

IUPAP and IOMP Travel Awards to ICMP 2023

IOMP is pleased to announce that the International Union of Pure and Applied Physics (IUPAP), with support from IOMP, has awarded grants to assist in the traveling expenses of young medical physicists from low-and middle-income countries (LMICs) to participate in the International Conference on Medical Physics – 2023 (ICMP-2023).

a) Grants according to the region

- 1) SAARC region - [Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan, and Sri Lanka] - € 300
- 2) Asia, Africa, Middle East- € 700
- 3) Latin America - € 1000

Five candidates who meet the requirements will receive the grant.

After the Conference, each awardee should submit, within 2 weeks, a short report to the IOMP Secretary-General on what was accomplished.

b) Criteria for application:

- 1) The applicant should be under 40 years old as of 31 December 2023 and be in the 5 years of research development in medical physics.
- 2) The applicant should have an abstract accepted for presentation at ICMP 2023.
- 3) The applicant should be the first author of the abstract.
- 4) The applicant should not have received any previous IOMP travel assistance.
- 5) The participant should be from an LMIC country.

c) Nomination procedure

- 1) Nominations should be made directly to the Chair of the Professional Relation Committee (simonekodlulovich@gmail.com). The applicant should fill out the IOMP form grant (<https://forms.gle/B8K3Z9teX4VZo5tu6>).
- 2) The applicant should send the acceptance letter of the abstract.

The closing date for applications is noon (EST) on 17 November 2023
